Project Services

- **Assistive Technology Lending Library:** Equipment, software, videos and print materials available to public school staff for preview and evaluation purposes.
- **Professional Development & Technical Assistance:** In-person and online training and support on devices, strategies, tools and materials.
- **Universal Design for Learning Support:** Training and technical assistance available.
- **Fall Statewide Implementation Conference:** The best national and local presenters share what works with students. Typically in November.
- **Spring Statewide Tech Expo:** Assistive technology vendors and service providers available all day for demonstration and Q&A. Typically in April.
- **AEM Targeted Assistance:** Year-long, intensive support to bring district into sustainability.

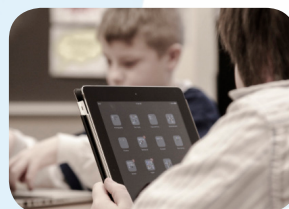
Through PATINS, ICAM services are available at no cost to Indiana's PreK-12 public educators.

The ICAM works closely with the Indiana Educational Resource Center (IERC) to provide a full range of specialized formats of materials (NIMAS, braille, large print, ePubs, accessible PDFs, audio and more).

ICAM Services

- **Provide** guidance on the use of accessible content in curriculum delivery and process material requests.
- **Maintain** a state-wide tracking system for accountability of local educational agencies.
- **Ensure** protection of the copyright process.

The Indiana Center for Accessible Materials (ICAM) is the Indiana repository that assists Indiana's local education agencies in meeting the NIMAS regulations of the 2004 IDEA reauthorization by securing specialized formats of accessible textbooks and core curriculum materials in a timely manner for students with documented print disabilities.
